I want to move controls(labels, buttons, textboxes, etc.) from one form to another by simply dragging them to another form. For example: I drag a button from the left form to the right form I drop the button on the form The controls on the form which is at the center now starts moving, too. I want to do this in a similar way (with any kind of controls) as it is done by the gallery of picture in windows. I don't want to make any changes in the design of the forms. So, is it possible? If not, how can i achieve it? A: you can override the control's OnMouseDown and OnMouseMove event to track the mouse and determine if it is within a certain range and, if it is, reposition the control.
